Anti-racist political education and organizing is vital to vibrant social movements for global justice. Racism continues to fuel tremendous inequities within the U.S. and on a global scale. Racism also manifests in progressive social movements. Anti-racism is a powerful catalyst for building the movements we need to create a world in which no one's access to housing, income, food, education, healthcare, or other human rights are restricted based on race, gender, sexuality, age, ability, citizenship, or religion. We call this vision collective liberation, and it is at the core of our work.

Catalyst Project is a collective of antiracist white organizers who are active in a range of social justice efforts. We draw on our combined decades of organizing experience to offer political education, organizational development support, leadership development, and mentorship to white activists who want to increase the effectiveness and accountability of their efforts to address institutional and internalized racism.

Our approach is deeply inspired by the legacies of civil rights and Black Power organizing, and by women of color feminism. These movements have directly challenged white activists to stand against racism within white communities. Catalyst also draws on lessons from social movements outside the U.S., and we develop our work in collaboration with a multiracial, multigenerational community of mentors and organizers.

Our interactive, participatory trainings examine racism as a foundational divide-and-rule system in the U.S., and emphasize the intersections of multiple systems of oppression and privilege.
